The month of March saw the transportation department become fully staffed with four new hires. The new TAB manual was approved at the last months TAB meeting. WE are in the process of wrapping out two new vans and auctioning off one retired van and one retired Head Start school bus.

Information Systems Departmental – Henderson, Polk & Transylvania Counties Jonathan Stanley, Information Systems Director March 2022

The Information Systems Department team, made up of Director, Jonathan Stanley and Support Specialist, Cody Miller worked on a number of projects within WNCSource.

The Information Technology team spent the majority of the previous month providing in person and remote support to staff. Highlights from the last month include:

- New employee badges with new logo and design have been printed and distributed to all staff.
- The VPN between King Creek and the Flat Rock Children's Center has been established allowing the classroom camera system and VOIP phones system to now work properly and be accessible remotely.
- The IT department is currently wiring the Forest City Center for Wi-Fi and security cameras, to be completed during the 1st week of April.
- More security cameras and improved Wi-Fi have been added to the Bargain Hendo Thrift Store.

Facilities & Safety Department Report Tim Camp, Director February 2022

Maintenance Highlights:

Our maintenance team was contacted by the Storm Water Administrator with the City of Hendersonville concerning the status of the sediment pond located at King Creek Main Office. After review of the pond, it was determined some maintenance was required. The team has been working to clean up the overgrowth and clogged piping. Several trees, bushes, dirt, and trash have been removed. We will continue to monitor the pond and clear all clogs. New shade structures covering outside play areas for our students have been installed at Sugar Hill, Fletcher, Main St. and Etowah Children's Centers.

- **Tebeau Children's Center:** Grading and drainage systems are underway at Tebeau Children's Center. The footings for the new addition on the front building are being prepped and poured, which will include the re-pouring of the concrete floor in both buildings that had to be removed to run new plumbing.
- Forest City Children's Center: The remodel job at Forest City Children's Center is moving forward. New sidewalks have been completed. New sheetrock and windows have been installed along with a new HVAC system. The current targeted completion date is April 15th.
- **Bargain Hendo:** New WNCSource signs have been installed at the store.

Safety Highlights:

We conducted fire drills and tornado drills for office staff and retail thrift stores. These included King Creek Main Office, 7th Ave Apple Country, North Justice Street, Bargain Hendo Thrift Store, and Tiger Town Thrift Store.

We installed two new emergency exit signs at Tiger Town Thrift Store.

We created new evacuation route maps for the Bargain Hendo Thrift Store.

We installed directional caution tape in the work area at Bargain Hendo for emergency evacuation.
