The grant application supports WNCSource's Early Head Start programs in Henderson, Transylvania, Rutherford and Polk Counties.

Services will be delivered in a traditional classroom setting (Center-based) and through the establishment of four Family Child Care Homes.

The #04HP000443 proposal requests funding for 99 EHS program slots.

The requested funding outlined in the grant package includes:

\$2,169,167 in Federal Base Funding
\$54,229 for Training and Technical Assistance*
\$555,849 for Non-Federal Share (20%)
\$2,779,245 Total Grant Amount
