WHAT IS THE HEALTHY OPPORTUNITIES PILOT (HOP)

- Medicaid pilot program developed by the NC DHHS with a goal to ultimately improve health and save millions of dollars on treatment of clinical illnesses or conditions by investing in evidence-based interventions before health becomes a problem.
- Social Determinants of Health
 - Transportation
 - Nutrition
 - Housing
 - Interpersonal Safety
- HOP allows nonprofit Human Services Organizations (HSO's) to receive Medicaid reimbursements from Private Health Plans for services they provide to qualifying Medicaid members




THE PLAYERS



- Created by Dogwood Health Trust to lead Western NC in the administration of the State's Healthy Opportunities Pilot program (HOP)
- Network Lead for the HOP program – Serve as the connection between NC DHHS, Private Health Plans (PHP's), and Human Service Organizations (HSOs) participating in the Pilot
- Help recruit HSO's into the HOP program, support capacity building and provide training and technical assistance
- Oversee the WNC HSO Network, Reviews HSO invoices and forwards to PHP, Collects and reports Data for the HOP Program



THE PLAYERS

Human Service Organizations

- Nonprofit HSO's and community partners have applied to participate in the Healthy Opportunities Pilot and become part of the HSO Network
- Network participants will deliver services to high-risk Medicaid beneficiaries who have been approved to participate in the pilot
- HSO network participants will receive referrals for service through NCCare360 and be reimbursed



HOW DOES WNCSOURCE TRANSPORTATION FIT IN?



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- Impact Health needs a Transportation partner to provide health-related transportation for qualifying PILOT enrollees through vouchers for public transportation.
- Does not replace Non-Emergency Transportation covered by Medicaid
- Transportation to/from non-medical services that promote community engagement, improved health and well-being including:
 - Grocery stores/Farmers Market
 - Job Interviews or work
 - Recreation centers, gyms, public parks
 - Places of worship, community meetings
 - Locations where other approved Pilot services are delivered



Partnership Proposition:



Capacity Building:

- Purchase a new Transit Van outfitted with communications, camera system, GPS locator, safety equipment, etc.
- Hire additional Scheduler/Dispatch Operator and Van Driver
- New Computer w/software
- Training & Uniforms

Initial Investment paid for by Impact Health:
\$162,033

Reimbursement Rates:

Service Name	Fee Schedule
Reimbursement for Health-Related Public Transportation	\$102/month
Reimbursement for Health-Related Private Transportation	\$267/month
Transportation PMPM Add-On for Case Management Services	\$71.30/month
