#### Facilities & Safety Department Report Tim Camp, Director September 2023

## <u> Maintenance Highlights:</u>

Our maintenance team continues work on landscaping in all counties. This includes mulch replacement where needed, landscaping, fence repairs, and gutter cleaning. The installation of all OLE playground equipment is complete.

#### **Columbus Children's Center:**

The building contractor has completed the prep work for the footings and slab. The geotechnical engineers have reviewed and approved the preparation work. Below grade plumbing has been completed and passed state inspection. The below grade electrical is almost complete and will be inspected the first of next week. Next steps are to install rebar, stone, poly, and wire mesh, and to complete termite treatment. The slab and footers will be poured as soon as all work passes state inspection.

#### Safety Highlights:

This month our safety team completed the safety and maintenance walk-throughs at 23 of our locations. These inspections included all children services locations, office buildings, adult services, and thrift stores. We also completed 3rd quarter fire drills at all non-children's services locations. We reviewed the broken entrance ramp at Hillview Children's Center and determined there was no structural damage. Parts needed to make the repairs have been ordered.

# Information Systems Departmental – Henderson, Polk & Transylvania Counties Jonathan Stanley, Information Systems Director September 2023

The Information Systems Department team, made up of Director, Jonathan Stanley and Support Specialist, Cody Miller worked on a number of projects within WNCSource.

The Information Technology team spent the majority of the previous month providing in person and remote support to staff. Highlights from the last month include:

- We have deployed 40 laptops and 20 iPads purchased with money from a special grant to enhance classroom connectivity and productivity. We still have 20 more iPads to deploy to classrooms to complete our CS tech upgrade round.
- We supplied technology needs to the new classroom at Edneyville Elementary School and worked with the school IT department to get special network access to accommodate our connectivity needs.
- We have helped a number of new employees with laptops, smartphones and the necessary badge access to sites across our agency.

The WNCSource Information Systems department provides support to all staff and we maintain the following equipment:
