#### Facilities & Safety Department Report Tim Camp, Director December 2023

## <u>Bargain Hendo:</u>

The maintenance team assisted in the closing of Bargain Hendo Thrift Store. We donated items to multiple locations, disposed of unwanted and unusable items, delivered items to multiple WNCSource facilities, and disassembled and assembled multiple racks and storage units.

#### Hillview Children's Center:

Horizon Heating & Air performed an inspection/diagnosis of a HVAC system at Hillview to determine why it had stopped working. The required repairs have been made and this project has been completed.

## King Creek Children's Center:

Our HVAC contractor, Horizon, advised that the heat exchangers on HVAC units #2 & #4 are both cracked and need replacing. Due to the age of the systems and the cost of the replacement parts, the decision was made to replace both units. These units have been replaced with no loss of instructional time.

## **Columbus Children's Center (New Center):**

The building contractor has completed roof framing, sheathing, and shingles. Electrical, plumbing, HVAC, and gas lines are currently being installed in the walls and exposed ceiling. The next steps will be the installation of the steel ladder, wiring for communications and security, and the installation of the sheetrock.

# Safety Highlights:

Safety checks and inspections of buildings and playgrounds were conducted to ensure we are prepared for winter temperatures. Classroom temperatures were checked prior to the return of staff and students to ensure compliance to guidelines. Repairs were made to the one classroom found not to be in compliance.

The Information Systems Department team, made up of Director, Jonathan Stanley and Support Specialist, Cody Miller worked on a number of projects within WNCSource.

The Information Technology team spent the majority of the previous month providing in person and remote support to staff. Highlights from the last month include:

- The IT department is rolling out remote access software to all desktops and laptops to facilitate remote support and troubleshooting. The software package we are using is called Rustdesk.
- We removed all equipment and disconnected services at Bargain Hendo, including internet access, Wi-Fi, point-of-sale and camera systems prior to the holiday break.
