Facilities & Safety Department Report Tim Camp, Director March 2024

Our maintenance team has started working on landscaping across the four counties we represent. This includes winter clean up, the removal of fallen limbs, replacement of mulch where needed, grass cutting, cleaning gutters, and the trimming of bushes and trees. The team has also been working on equipment and supplies to ensure we are prepared for spring-cleaning and any repairs that may need to be performed to keep us in compliance.

7th Avenue Offices:

Our maintenance team has removed and replaced the damaged flooring in both of the men's restrooms. This was a safety requirement due to splitting tiles and sinking toilets caused by the damage.

King Creek Children's Center:

Back sidewalks/patios around the building, walls, and doors have been cleaned and pressure washed.

Columbus Children's Center (New Center):

The building contractor has completed the installation of the outside Hardie Board siding, the inside insulation and sheetrock. The security and fire contractors have received the final approval from the fire marshal. This allows them to continue installing the next phase of the electrical installation. Next steps will be to paint the outside of the building trim and walls, wrapping the columns with stone siding, and installation of the acoustical ceiling grid.

Safety Highlights:

- We completed this quarter's safety checks and building inspections at all locations.
- Paula Bynnom, a Substance Abuse Counselor, presented to the Safety Committee and WNCSource Management. SAP Counselors are a requirement for our Transportation Department, and the training they provide is relevant and proactive for the entire agency.

Information Systems Departmental – Henderson, Polk & Transylvania Counties Jonathan Stanley, Information Systems Director March 2024

The Information Systems Department team, made up of Director, Jonathan Stanley and Support Specialist, Cody Miller worked on a number of projects within WNCSource.

The Information Technology team spent the majority of the previous month providing in person and remote support to staff. Highlights from the last month include:

- We have begun replacing cameras at some locations with 360° cameras that allow greater coverage/visibility and higher resolution
- We have started adding Rustdesk remote access support to agency laptop and desktop computers to aid our department in remote troubleshooting as well as inventory record keeping.
- We have submitted our RFP selection to the E-Rate portal. This mostly concludes the application process for the coming fiscal year. We will continue receiving internet service subsidies through this program through June 30, 2025.

The WNCSource Information Systems department provides support to all staff and we maintain the following equipment:
