WNCSource Secures Grant to Offer Developmental Day Programs for Special Needs Children in Henderson County

- WNCSource is excited to announce that it has received a generous grant from the Dogwood Health Trust to support Developmental Day programs for special needs children in Henderson County.
- Developmental Day programs provide educational services and therapeutic care to preschool-age children with behavioral, physical, or developmental challenges to help them prepare for school.
- Earlier this year, Henderson County Public Schools began contracting with WNCSource to provide the Developmental Day program at its Tebeau Children's Center in Hendersonville where the nonprofit operates Head Start programs.
- WNCSource operates two DD classrooms with a mix of special needs and typical children
 to provide an inclusive learning environment where all children thrive. Professional
 therapists conduct weekly occupational, physical, and speech therapy to support the
 children's needs.
- Grant funding will help support first-year operating costs for the Developmental Day program including increased staffing, contract therapeutic services, and year-round education and care.

Earlier this year, Henderson County Public Schools contracted WNCSource to provide the Developmental Day program at the Tebeau Children's Center in Hendersonville, where the nonprofit also operates Head Start early education programs. HCPS refers children with special needs to the Developmental Day program. The collaboration has enabled WNCSource to extend its commitment to inclusive education through two specialized classrooms designed to include a mix of special needs and typically developing children, fostering an environment where all students can learn and grow together.

In addition to inclusive education, professional therapists offer weekly occupational, physical, and speech therapy sessions to address the diverse needs of the children in the program. The funding from Dogwood Health Trust will play a crucial role in covering the first-year operating costs for the Developmental Day program. This includes increased staffing, enhanced therapeutic services, and providing year-round education and care.

"We are deeply grateful for the support from Dogwood Health Trust," said Linda Carter, Director of Children's Services. "This grant enables us to expand our services and continue making a meaningful difference in the lives of children with special needs and their families in Henderson County."
